# Our Story of *Giving Hope* and Saving Lives

## The Australian Bone Marrow Donor Registry and BMDI Cord Blood Bank

Fight Cancer Foundation was formed in 1989 as the Bone Marrow Donor Institute and was instrumental in the creation of The Australian Bone Marrow Donor Registry and BMDI Cord Blood Bank, both providing life-saving opportunities for patients with leukaemia, lymphoma, myeloma and other blood disorders.

Following these successful projects, Fight Cancer Foundation today focuses on funding vital research, youth education and accommodation support which positively impact people living with cancer and their families.

## Research

Our scientists based at the Translational Haematological Research Laboratories at the Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre and Royal Melbourne Hospital are at the forefront of discovering crucial outcomes in their life-saving research.

## Education Programs

We provide young patients with the opportunity to continue their education during long-term treatment and recovery, providing them with a positive focus and the opportunity to achieve their full educational and professional potential.

## Accommodation Centres

We provide long and short term accommodation in Melbourne, Hobart and Albury for patients and their families who need comfortable and affordable accommodation during ongoing medical treatment. Families face overwhelming and daunting challenges, emotionally and financially, causing immense upheaval as they try to cope with the changes serious illness brings to their lives.
